


Virtual Tour of the city of São Paulo

Course Description: The focus of the Brazilian Portuguese for Foreign Students course is to offer the experience of understanding and producing effective communication in the target language at Basic Level, including a comprehension on culture issues and the promotion of intercultural awareness.

Course Objectives: This course develops the four communication skills in Brazilian Portuguese at Basic Level: reading, listening, writing and speaking. After completing this course, students should be able to communicate in Brazilian Portuguese, in daily life situations, write short texts, introduce themselves, communicate to get directions in the city, describe daily routines as well as, understand the Brazilian cultural background.

Learning Objectives:

Some of the learning objectives are:

1. To develop the ability to greet, introduce and talk about yourself and ask information about others;
2. To talk about your own routine;
3. To talk about professions and work activities;
4. To ask questions about daily life, telling time and talk about the weather;
5. To make comparisons, make purchases using measurement units;
6. To understand and give directions;
7. To communicate in public places: at a restaurant, at the hotel, at the airport, in a store;

Class Size and Study Structure for

- Small and intimate discussion based classes, capped (limited to) at 100 students.
- Course load of up to 3 courses for UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS REGISTERED independently equivalent to 180 credit hours per semester equivalent to 12 ECTs.
- GRADUATE Exchange students must be registered in a minimum of 6 courses, equivalent to 360 hours (equivalent to 24 ECTs, to be considered full time).

INCOMING STUDENTS VISA (TOURISTS OR STUDENT)

If you are coming for less than 90 days, we recommend that you enter Brazil using a Tourist visa. It is much easier to get it than a Student Visa.

The visa is the document granted by Consular Representations of Brazil abroad that allows the expectation of admission and stay of foreigners in the national territory, provided that the conditions established by law have been met.

To apply for a visa, foreigners must submit the visa application form completed, a valid travel document, proof of payment of consular fees, International Certificate of Immunization - when necessary, and other specific documents for the type of visa requested. In the case of TOURIST VISA OR STUDENT VISA, FECAP will provide you with the ACCEPTANCE LETTER.

STUDENT VISA: How to get a Student Visa for Brazil

Wondering how to get a STUDENT VISA for Brazil?

For people who want to study in Brazil for a longer period (more than 90 days), FECAP will help you with the STUDENT VISA process. You will find here a list of documents necessary for you to get your visa in your country. The only document students need from an educational institution in order to apply for a Student Visa to Brazil is a Letter of Acceptance. The Student Visa for Brazil is valid for the period the student is studying, this means that there is no minimum course duration to apply for a visa.

Wondering how to get a STUDENT VISA for Brazil?

If you are applying for a Visa while in your country, you should apply through the Consulate (Step 1).

Completion of the electronic form.

Schedule service (if requested in Brazil).

The "Request or Application Code" will be provided upon completion of step 1!

Passport with at least six months validity.

Letter of Acceptance proving enrollment in the desired course.

Two 3×4 photos.

Birth certificate.

Proof of payment of fees for residence permit and issuance of the National Migration Registration Card.

Criminal background certificates or equivalent document issued by the competent judicial authority where you have resided in the last five years.

Declaration, under penalty of law, of absence of a criminal record in any country for the last five years. Forms available at: <https://www.gov.br/pt-br/servicos/emitir-certidao-de-antecedentes-criminais>.

Documentation that proves the financial capacity of the applicant or those responsible for maintaining the applicant in Brazil during the period he/she intends to remain in the country, or proof that he/she was awarded a scholarship.

Documentation proving that the interested party is attending an undergraduate course at a foreign university, in case of a residence permit for an internship or study or research exchange.

Federal Police Appointment after arrival in Brazil is Necessary.

Step-by-Step to make and appointment at the Federal Police:

The Federal Police only accepts the students that are scheduled on the website. If it passes 90 days after your arrival, there is the possibility that you have to pay a fine, which they will inform you once you are there, so be prepared. The Brazilian authorities require International student to register their visa in the first 90 days of their arrival.

Students have to request an appointment at the federal Police website: <http://www.pf.gov.br>

Make sure that you request your appointment within 05 days of your arrival to have enough time to pay the required fees and get official documents. In case the students fail to register the visa within in the 90 days, they will pay a daily fine for the authorities and may jeopardize their stay in the country.
